*This Notice of Race is issued by Kurnell Catamaran Club Incorporated (KCC). The organising authority and officials consist of the KCC elected Executive Committee for the current season and rostered duty personnel.*

### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021 – 2024 (RRS), Appendix B- Windsurfer Fleet Racing Rules.
- 1.2 The Class Rules shall apply unless modified by the sailing instructions (SIs).
- 1.3 If there is conflict between the Notice of Race and the SIs, the SIs will take precedence.

### 4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 Entry is open to all course racing Windsurfers.
- 4.2 KCC is a Covid registered organisation with the NSW Government. The KCC Covid plan requires all attendees to register their details to facilitate contract tracing (as required by the NSW Government).
- 4.3 All attendees are to sign the declaration on the entry form to acknowledge their compliance with the prevailing NSW Government regulations at 0900 hrs on the 20th of February 2022.
- 4.4 KCC is not responsible for any fines or claims arising from any individual's failure to comply with the prevailing Covid regulations.

### 5 Divisions

- 5.1 A minimum of 4 competitors is required to constitute a division.
- 5.2 Divisions will be: **Division 1** Race boards, **Division 2** Foilers, **Division 3** BIC Techno. More divisions (4,5 etc) may be created on the day at the discretion of the PRO.

### 6 Fees

- 6.1 All entries \$25.
- 6.2 Entry fees, unless paid previously to state associations, are payable on the day of the event at the KCC Sailboard registration desk. Eftpos will be available.
- 6.3 Entrants must have paid their entry fee and complete their registration and Covid declaration prior to competing in any race.



## 7 Schedule of Events

There will be one session of up to 5 'back to back', warning signal not before 12:00 on Sunday 20th February 2022. Parking at KCC has become more difficult in recent times, please bear this in mind when planning your arrival time.

## 8 Measurements

Measurement and/or class measurement certificates are not required, but the Race Committee reserves the right to inspect any individual board for compliance with relevant class rules.

9.1 The Sailing Instructions (final copy) will be available from 8am on Sunday 20th February 2022 at the KCC Sailboard registration desk.
