This Notice of Race is issued by Kurnell Catamaran Club Incorporated (KCC). This Notice of Race is dated 5th February 2019 and is valid until superseded by a later dated version as issued by the Kurnell Catamaran Club Race Secretary, Assistant Race Secretary or an authorised Committee Member.

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the 2017 - 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Special Regulations of Australian Sailing, individual class rules and the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The Botany Bay Classic Regatta is open to all "off the beach" Catamarans/multi-hulls and Multi-hulls over 6.2 metres LOA may also enter the "Cock of the Bay".
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter on the official entry form, available at the KCC Clubhouse at least 1 hour prior to the scheduled start of the race.

3. Fees

Fees are payable at the KCC Clubhouse. Boats must complete and sign the entry form and pay the prescribed fee prior to competing. Results shall not be recorded where boats have not completed and signed the entry form and/or paid the prescribed fee.

“Cock of the Bay” is a marathon course around various marks defining the extremities of Botany Bay.
