This Notice of Race is issued by Kurnell Catamaran Club Incorporated (KCC). The organising authority and officials consist of the KCC elected Executive Committee and rostered duty personnel.

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by rules as defined in the current World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing, the Special Regulations of Australian Sailing, relevant class rules and the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Entry is open to all "off the beach" catamarans.
- 2.2 Class Associations wishing to conduct Class Events are welcome – Please contact the Race Secretary – Details below.
- 2.3 Entry forms are available at the KCC Clubhouse at least 2 hours prior to the scheduled start of the first race.

3. Race Fees

3.1	Senior (18+)	Double Handed \$85	Single Handed \$75
	*Junior (U18)	Double Handed \$40	Single Handed \$30

*Junior Double Handed – both must be U18 (U25 if a student).

- Fees are payable at the Regatta registration desk. (EFTPOS available)
- Entrants must pay the prescribed entry fee and complete their Regatta Entry Registration, prior to competing in any race.

4. Schedule of Events

- There will be 2 Race Sessions of up to 4 races each session from 11:30 hrs on Saturday 2nd November 2024 and from 09:00 hrs on Sunday 3rd November 2024.
- Starting Divisions: At the discretion of the Race Committee and advised at Regatta Briefing.
- **Regatta Briefing is at 10:00 hrs on Saturday 2nd November 2024**

5. Sailing Instructions

Limited abbreviated printed copies of the Sailing Instructions (final copy) are available from 8am on Saturday 2nd November 2024 at the Regatta registration desk. A full copy is posted on the Regatta Notice Board at the KCC Clubhouse.

A draft full copy (which becomes “Final” from 8am Saturday 2nd November 2024) may be available for download from the KCC Web Site (www.kcc.asn.au) prior to this time.

6. Course

The course is windward/leeward for all divisions - Refer to Sailing Instructions.

7. Scoring

Timed “on the water” finishes for all divisions for calculation of the “Top Gun” Catamaran of the Regatta. Results are calculated using current Australian Sailing Catamaran Yardsticks. Refer to Sailing Instructions for more information.

8. Measurement

- 8.1. Measurement of boats and/or sails, or provision of class compliance certificates, is not required. However, the Race Committee reserves the right to inspect any individual boat for compliance with class rules.
- 8.2. Class Associations may require members/entrants to strictly comply with class rules (current measurement certificates etc) and be financial members of the Class Association etc, at their absolute discretion, for the awarding of Class Association trophies/prizes.

9. Racing Area

Botany Bay – Sydney, Australia.

10. Club Facilities

- Extensive grassed rigging area and sandy beach for launching.
- Full use of Club facilities including hot showers, toilets, shaded veranda with tables/chairs and elevated view of race area.
- Club Canteen available for lunch, snacks, tea/coffee, soft drinks and beer/wine (subject to licensing restrictions). EFTPOS available.
- Limited camping may be available within club grounds. (Contact KCC President – refer contact details below).

At the discretion of the KCC Executive/Regatta Race Committee.
